

### 3 THE DIPLOMA OF THE EUROPEAN SCHOOL OF LAW



The ESL offers a specific diploma to complement the main training. It enables students to enhance their knowledge of the legal system of the European Union as well as improve their grasp of the diversity of legal traditions in Europe, in order to better articulate the various national legal orders. Through the management of a project of European dimension and the resolution of a concrete case, the students will become familiar with the practice of European law.

One or several internships in the private or public sector are recommended.

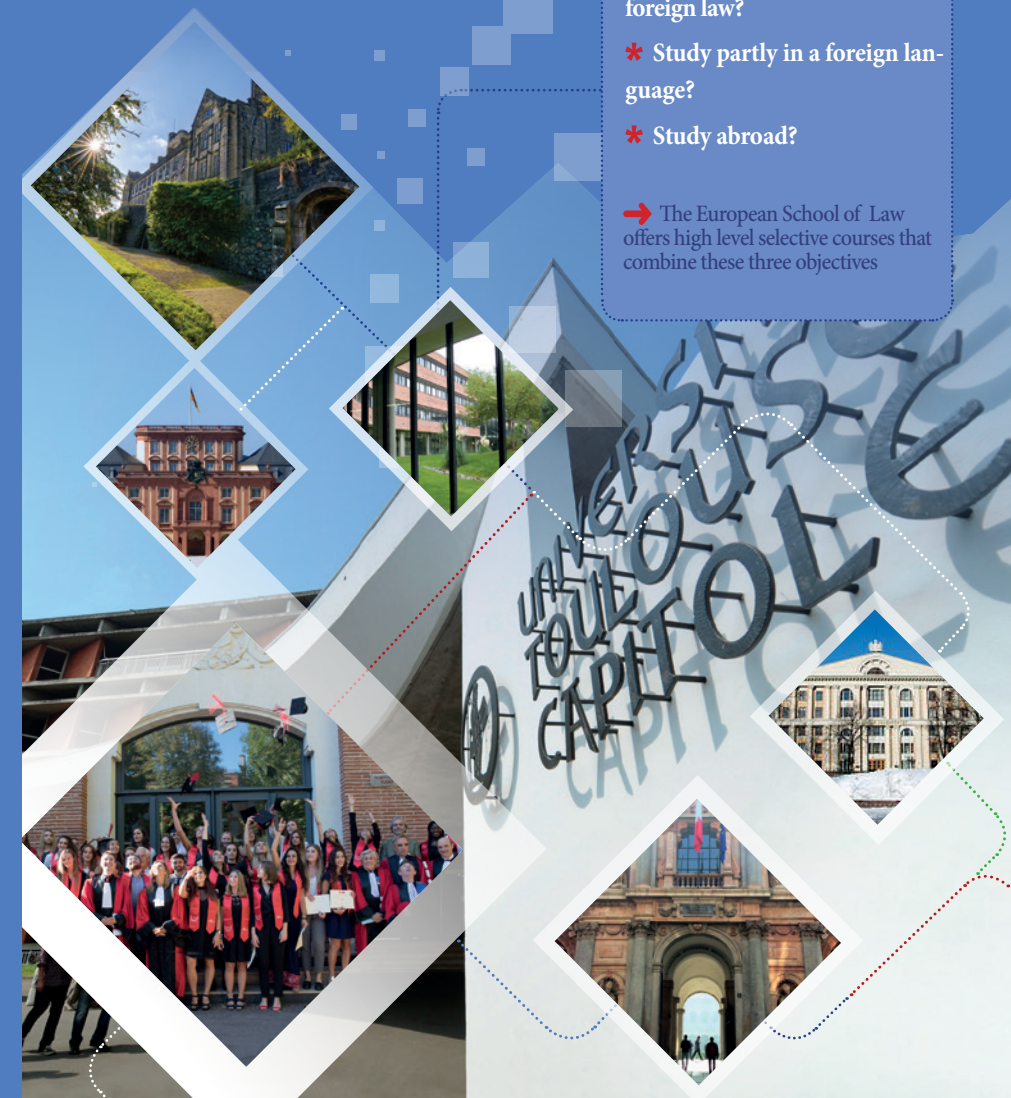
## International programmes in law in higher education

### The + of bilingual licences

→ Specific courses entirely bilingual inside the law licence: you will take part of a school year of 30 students maximum. You will have a large choice of universities for your mobility school year abroad.

As part of the French law and common law licence, you will have the possibility of a double degree with University Colleg Dublin in the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of the licence and the 1<sup>st</sup> year of the Master, with a mobility for two years instead of one.

→ You will be graduate in the partner university. The double degrees enable to applicate for Masters, LLM or post-graduate of a lot of countries, without any problem of equivalence. They also allow to participate, in France or abroad, at the courses for becoming lawyer (Master or specific access exam).\*

\* Except for Germany, where there's specific way to be able to practice as a lawyer in this country.
